

Letter Quick Pick Definitions

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Quick picks are used to populate a wide variety of data points from the patient's chart or specific encounters onto a letter and/or SOAP Note. This article will describe the available quick picks within the letters setup section of the system.

Definitions

All quick picks include << prefix and >> suffix when displayed in the Letters Setup and required for the quick pick to pull in the data.

Quick Pick Name	Description & Display Example
Patient Encounter Orders - Appointment Provider	Orders during an encounter where the Rendering Provider = Scheduled Resource Orders Display Example: • {Order 1} for ({Dx1}, {Dx2}..) • {Order 2} for ({Dx1}, {Dx2}..)
Patient Encounter Rx Detailed New - Appointment Provider	Medications with the status of New & Prescribed By the Scheduled Resource. New Medications Display Example: • {RxName, Dispense, Start}
Patient Preferred Pharmacy Name	This quick pick shows the patient's preferred pharmacy as a comma separated list. Patient Preferred Pharmacy Example: Pharmacy1 (NCPDP#), Pharmacy2 (NCPDP#), Pharmacy3 (NCPDP#),
Patient Preferred Pharmacy List Name	This quick pick shows the patient's preferred pharmacy as a bulleted list Patient Preferred Pharmacy Example: • Pharm1 (NCPDP#) • Pharm2 (NCPDP#)
