

New Company Setting - Override Default referring to rend. provider when Medicare Requirement

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The "Override Default referring to rend. provider when Medicare Requirement" company setting allows a practice to enter a comma delimited list of provider IDs that should ignore the setting "Default referring to rend. provider when Medicare" in order to align with Medicare's implementation of a new guideline edit that allows Audiologist to provide certain services without the need of a referring provider. Once a provider ID has been set in the override settings, validation of the referring and rendering providers will NOT occur when that provider is designated as rendering on a Medicare claim.
