

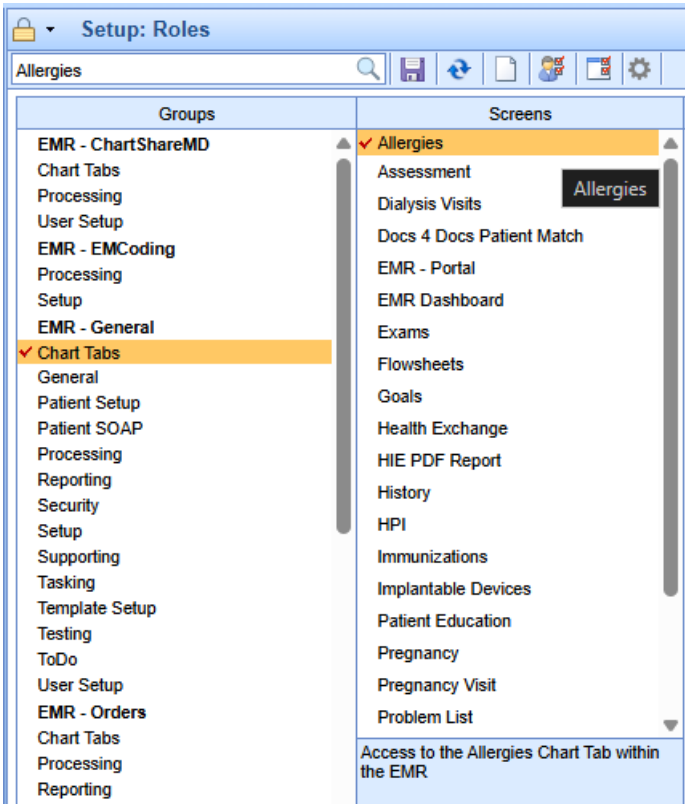
Allergies Security & Settings

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This article describes the necessary permission(s) needed to access the Allergies chart tab, as well as the related Company & User Settings for the screen.

Roles & Security Screens

Company Settings

Company Setting Name	Description
EMR Codified Allergy Required	If checked, only codified allergies can be saved for the patient. This includes Allergies added by the Patient on Intelligent Intake.

User Settings

User Setting Name	Description
Display Todays Allergy History	If checked, todays allergy history will be displayed as a popup window on the Allergies tab within the EMR.
