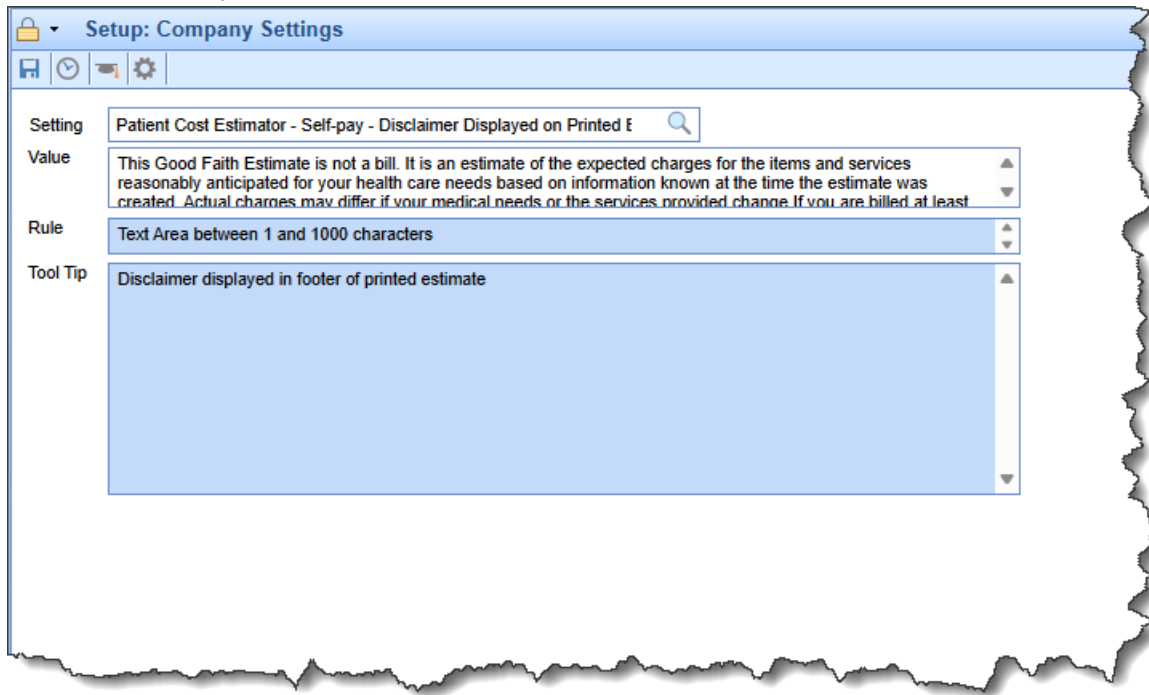


Company Setting: Patient Cost Estimator - Self Pay - Disclaimer Displayed on Printed Estimate

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The "**Patient Cost Estimator - Self Pay - Disclaimer Displayed on Printed Estimate**" company setting allows a practice to configure the disclaimer for Cost Estimates to automatically detect when the patient is not insured (self-pay) and pull the correct disclaimer accordingly. You can use the default disclaimer, or create your own (up to 1000 characters).

Options:

- Off (no message in the value field) - no disclaimer is displayed in the footer of a cost estimate for Self Pay patients.
- On (a message is in the value field) - a disclaimer message is displayed in the footer of a cost estimate for Self Pay patients.
